  - Knowing ISL empowers you to advocate for the rights and needs of the HoH community.
  - To broaden your perspective , challenge your preconceptions, and encourage empathy and compassion.
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# Course Structure

## Week 1: Introduction

- Briefly Talk about Indian Sign Language and learn gestures of the word ISL
  - Get to know each other (Chat Box)
  - Introducing few sign languages to interact with the Instructor (Hello, Sorry, Thank you, Welcome, Yes, No, Clap, Help, No idea, Please, Teacher, Stop, Wait, Happy, Sad, Excited, Help, Teacher, Clap, Welcome, Class, Topic, ISL, My Sign Name, Good Morning Good Afternoon, Good Night and Good Evening)
  - Sign Language Name task (How to define oneself)
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## WEEK 2:

- Recap of the sign words and sign names
- Introducing the first 13 alphabets (A-M) in sign language
- Introducing Numbers (1-20) in sign language

## **WEEK 3:**

- Recap of Alphabets and Numbers
  - Introducing remaining 13 alphabets (N-Z) in sign language
  - Question and Answer session (10 mins)
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## **WEEK 4:**

- Recap of all Alphabets in sign language
  - Recap of all Numbers in sign language
  - Recap of all Sign Language words
  - Introducing names of Months (January - December)
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## **WEEK 5:**

- Introducing names of colors (white, pink, blue, black, red, purple, yellow, green, grey, silver, golden, light brown, dark brown, orange, light blue, dark blue, dark green) in sign language
- Introducing sign name for Week and Days (Monday - Sunday)
- Question and Answer session (10 mins)

## **WEEK 6:**

- Introducing names of animals - Dog, Cat, Fish, Rabbit, Cow, Duck, Goat, Snake, Tiger, Lion, Elephant, Bird, Crow, Lizard, Cockroach, Spider) in sign language
  - Introducing Sign Language for Transportation: Aeroplane, Bus, Train, Auto, Rickshaw, Taxi, Ship, Metro Rail, Walk, Bicycle, Motorbike, Car, Truck, Van, Tram
  - Question and Answer session (10 mins)
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## **WEEK 7:**

- Introducing Sign Language for Family members: Mother, Father, Brother, Sister, Uncle, Aunty, Grand-father, Grand Mother, Cousin, Son and Daughter
- Introducing few more sign language for words like: Before, After, Front, Back, Work, Topic, Today, Tomorrow, Yesterday, Come, Go, Sleep, Wake up, Food, Water, Toilet, How, Why, What, When, I , You, We, They, Tree, Flower, Leaves
- Question and Answer session (10 mins)

## WEEK 8:

- Basic Conversation in Sign Language:
  - a. What are you doing?
  - b. Where are you going?
  - c. How was your day?
  - d. When are you coming back?
  - e. What did you eat?
  - f. I am working
  - g. I am sleeping
  - h. I am cooking
  - i. I am going out
  - j. I am playing
  - k. Few Words: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner, Take Care, I am feeling Sick
